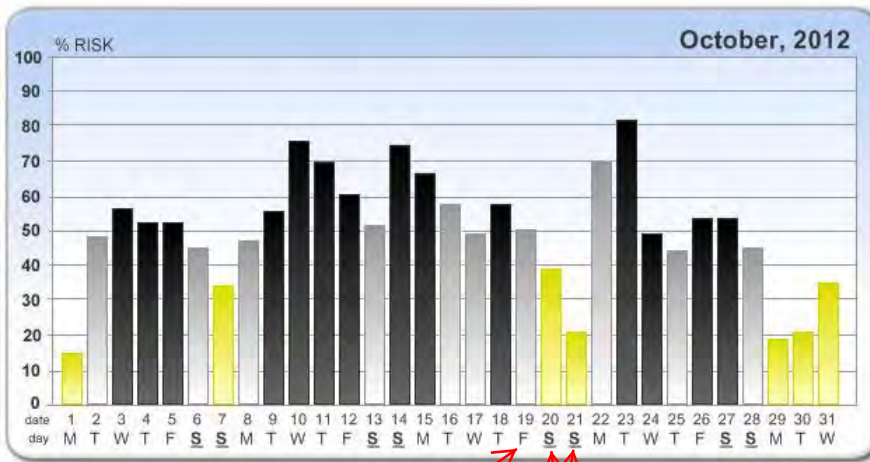




Long Range Weather Forecast

Set-Up Day

Show Dates

Identify Dry Periods

DRYDAY® weather forecasts are designed to help in planning outdoor activities. These forecasts indicate, months in advance, the dates in which there is little risk for rain.

Risky Days

Each bar represents the risk of rain by percentage for the specified date. Expect most of the rain to fall on RISKY days (black bars), but don't expect rain on all RISKY days.

Transition Days

The Transition days (gray bars) remind the user to try to avoid RISKY days by 24 hours whenever possible.

DRYDAY® Days

The remainder of the days (yellow bars) are "DRYDAY"® days with no measurable (0.01" - less than one-hundredth of an inch) rainfall expected.

Bar Height

The height of the bars represents the percentage risk associated with each day. In general, the lower the percentage risk, the more likely a day will be dry.

Based on past experiences and concerns by artists to participate in outdoor events where their success was hindered or limited primarily due to rainfall, the organizers of **Art In The Square Delray Beach** in an effort to appease those concerns has secured the above "Long range Weather Forecast" chart created by Dryday.com®.
